INTRODUCTION:

In pursuance of the National Action Plan of the National Assessment & Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore for performance, evaluation, assessment & accreditation and quality upgradation of Higher Education, the NAAC proposes that every accredited Institution establish an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) as post accreditation quality sustenance measure. Since quality enhancement is a continuous process, the IQAC will become part of an institution's system and works towards realizing the goals of quality enhancement & sustenance. Thus, the prime task of the IQAC is to develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the performance of institutions. Thus, during the post accreditation period, the IQAC will channelize the efforts and measures of an institution towards academic excellence.

THE FUNCTIONS OF THE IQAC:

- + Development and application of quality benchmarks/ parameters in various activities of the institution.*
- + Dissemination of information on quality aspects.*
- + Organization of Workshops/ Seminars & promotions of quality circles.*
- + Recording and monitoring quality measures of the institutions.*
- + Acting as an nodal agency of the institution for quality related activities*
- + Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) and such other Reports as may be decided from time to time.*
