## **2. Women's Association Programme for their Empowerment**

The resources and skills have been wasted so far by keeping females restricted to door steps. The well thought regular government programmes and policies have attracted, encouraged and sensitized the girls to go for higher education. Our college has active Women's Association's. It organizes and conducts various programmes to sensitize the staff and students with regard to gender discrimination and the need for gender equity. The following programmes are carried out during every academic year.

- Celebration of **International Women's Day**. It is much awaited, talked and the grandest event on the campus.
- Eminent women achievers in various fields are invited to enlighten and inspire the girls with rural background.
- Various rallies and awareness programmes highlight the evils of Female feticide, dowry system, domestic violence, in human act of rape, eve teasing and the need for women empowerment. These programmes help in sensitizing on gender equity in an effective manner.
- The entire staff of the college takes care of the safety of female students. There is lot of encouragement and some incentives for their progression in academic, extra-curricular, co-curricular and extension activities.
- The safety and incentives for the female students have yielded desired fruits. ***Among our three rankers and three gold medalists, five are girls.*** The college toppers are more girl students in the last five years. There is constant rise in the female strength in our college though the government run neighboring college provides free education for girls.
